

CV – Prof. Vasko Furnadjiev

Prof. Vasko Furnadjiev was born in 1943 in Bulgaria. He graduated from Technical University of Sofia. In 1978 he became a Doctor in the field of Computer-Aided-Design. Until 1999 he was a lecturer in Technical University of Sofia: teaching “Computer architecture”, Computer Networks”, “Computer-aided-design”, etc. and head of research lab “Local area computer networks”. From 1999 - 2010 he was an expert of the government of the Netherlands in the field of ICT education with 2 missions in Africa – in Tanzania (1999-2005) – to set up a new Department of Computer Science: at University of Dar es Salaam; and from 2006 – 2010 – in Ghana – to set up a new Institute for Advanced ICT Studies as a Vice Rector of this Institute. Prof. Furnadjiev have been invited as a lecturer in many Universities: Germany (Technical University – Ilmenau, University of applied sciences - Berlin), France (INSA – Rennes), etc. At the moment, prof. Furnadjiev is a lecturer in New Bulgarian University – Sofia. His research interests include: computer networks, distributed computing. He has more than 60 publications and 5 text books (in Bulgarian and in English).
